Open All Other Breeds Show Division 518

Rules:

1. Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate available for inspection at the show for each animal. Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.
2. Any female shown with calf at side, the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and the calf must be registered by show date and have the original registration certificate at check in.
3. Only one person at a time shall lead animals into the show ring.
4. Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of chin straps, covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.
5. No animal that is eligible to participate in Divisions 500, 502, 504, 506, 508, 510, 512, 513, 514 and 516 may participate in the All Other Breed Show. Only breeds that do not have a separate open show will be eligible to participate.

Junior Open All Other Breeds Show Division 519

Rules:

1. ****The animal entered in the Junior Show must also be entered in the Open Show.**
2. **Only a 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member may exhibit animals in this show and they must not have passed their 21st birthday on January 1 of the current year. NO LEASE ANIMALS ACCEPTED.**
3. **All animals/embryos exhibited must have been recorded or registered in the exhibitor's name on or before July 31 of the current year. All animals must be registered or recorded with their respective breed organizations. Entries must be in the sole, name of the 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member ONLY. Animals register in family, farm, chapter or club name will not be eligible to show in the Junior Show. Junior exhibitors must show proof of identification, such as a driver's license, birth certificate, or other ID showing date of birth.**
4. **Cow/Calf Classes will not compete for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female of the junior show.**
5. **Ribbons will be awarded for the first five placings. Rosette's awarded for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female.**
6. **No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.**
7. Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate available for inspection at the show for each animal. Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals

- cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.
8. Any female shown with calf at side, the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and the calf must be registered by show date and have the original registration certificate at check in.
 9. Only one person at a time shall lead animals into the show ring.
 10. Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of chin straps, covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.
 11. No animal that is eligible to participate in Divisions 501, 503, 505, 507, 509, 511, 515 and 517 may participate in the All Other Breed Show. Only breeds that do not have a separate junior show will be eligible to participate. The Brahman Juniors WILL BE ELIGIBLE to participate in the AOB Show.
