Open Shorthorn Show

Division 500

Rules:

1. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
2. **All cattle must be purebred and have an original American Shorthorn Association registration paper (no copies accepted or faxes accepted)** to be eligible to show. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the ASA by the time of the fair or show. Please refer to specific show guidelines for a junior show ownership deadline.
3. Animals in a Junior Show may only be in the sole name of the individual exhibitor.
4. Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes **for single** animals. Multiple owned animals must be exhibited in the name of all owners. Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors in Junior Divisions and subsequently entered in Open Divisions may be treated as family entries in group Divisions.
5. All Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the ASA.
6. All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the ASA and the DECISION OF THE EXAMINING VETERINARIAN IS FINAL.
7. Use of artificial fins in show animals is not permitted.

- Cls 23 Junior Yearling Females - calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, last year.
- Cls 24 Senior Yearling Females - calved between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, year before last.
- Cls 25 Sr. Champion Female - chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 23-24.
- Cls 26 Res Sr. Champ Female- chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in Cls 23-24.
- Cls 27 Two-Year Old Cow/Claf Class – cows born between Jan. 1 – Aug. 31, 2014.
- Cls 28 Three-Four Year Old Cow/Calf Class – cows born between Jan. 1, 2012 – Dec. 31, 2013.
Both Cow and calf must be Purebred Shorthorn – Calf age may not exceed 280 days of age on show day.
- Cls 29 Champion Cow/Calf pair – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners from Cls. 27-28.
- Cls 30 Reserve Champion Cow/Calf Pair – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners from Cls. 27-28.
- Cls 31 Grand Champion Female - chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior, Senior and Cow/Calf Pair Champion females.
- Cls 32 Reserve Grand Champion Female - chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior, Senior and Cow/Calf Pair Champion and Reserve Champion females.
- Cls 33 Group of Two Females bred and owned or co-owned by breeder (exhibitor).

Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all Open shows: If a Purebred Female has a ShorthornPlus calf at side, it is not eligible for the Purebred Shorthorn Show, however it is eligible for the ShorthornPlus show. All females 20 months old at the time of the show need to be a 60-day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show and are subject to blood test to prove pregnancy. Exhibitors may be asked to present said verification upon the request of the Show officials or ASA representatives. If verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site, and verify a 60-day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that animal for that specific show.

- Cls 40 Junior Bull Calves - calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, this year.

- Cls 47 Summer Yearling Bulls - calved between July 1 and August 31, last year.
- Cls 48 Late Spring Yearling Bulls - calved between May 1 and June 30, last year.
- Cls 49 Intermediate Champion Bull– chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 47-48.
- Cls 50 Reserve Intermediate Champion Bull—chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in Cls 47-48.
- Cls 51 Early Spring Yearling Bulls - calved between March 1 and April 30, last year.

- Cls 57 Senior Champion Bull - Chosen from 1st place winners from Cls 55-56.
- Cls 58 Res Sr. Champion Bull - Chosen from 1st & 2nd place from Cls 55-56.
- Cls 59 Grand Champion Bull - Chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior, and Senior Champion bulls.
- Cls 60 Reserve Grand Champion Bull - Chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior and Senior Champion and Reserve Champion bulls.

- Cls 61 Group of Two Bulls - Bred and owned or co-owned by the breeder (exhibitor).
- Cls 62 Super Cow Division - Class should consist of two (2) offspring of either or same sex of show age classification. Offspring do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one pair from each cow can win a prize in the class.
- Cls 63 Get-of-Sire Division - Class should consist of three offspring, of either or same sex of any age from the same sire. Offspring do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one group from each sire can win a prize in the class..
- Cls 64 Breeders Herd- Owned or co-owned by the exhibitor or working family (ie Father, Mother, Brothers, Sisters, Aunts & Uncles).

Junior Open Shorthorn Show

Division 501

Rules:

1. **The animal entered in the Junior Show must also be entered in the Open Show.
2. Only a 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member may exhibit animals in this show and they must not have passed their 21st birthday on January 1 of the current year. NO LEASE ANIMALS ACCEPTED.
3. All animals/embryos exhibited must have been recorded or registered in the exhibitor's name on or before July 31 of the current year. All animals must be registered or recorded with their respective breed organizations. Entries must be in the sole, name of the 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member ONLY. Animals registered in family, farm, chapter or club name will not be eligible to show in the Junior Show. Junior exhibitors must show proof of identification, such as a driver's license, birth certificate, or other ID showing date of birth.
4. Cow/Calf Classes will not compete for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female of the junior show.
5. Ribbons will be awarded for the first five placings. Rosette's awarded for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
6. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
7. All decisions by the beef superintendent regarding eligibility in the Junior Show are final.
