2. Beeswax must be one pound or more.
3. Articles made of beeswax must be made by the exhibitor.
4. Frames of honey must be placed in a sanitary, bee-proof container.
5. Comb honey can be in either round or square sections and should be 8 oz. or larger.
6. All honey and beeswax must be produced by the exhibitor.
7. No products should be labeled.
8. Release Time: Entries may be removed on the Monday following the Fair from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.. All unclaimed articles will be collected by the Nashville Beekeepers Association.
