Rules:

1. All entries must be grown by the school exhibitor at their school garden site.
2. Only one entry per school under the same class number.
3. Prizes are awarded to school for continuation/improvement of school garden program.
4. All entries not claimed will become the property of the Tennessee State Fair Association.
5. Entries will be received from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Agricultural Building on Thursday prior to opening day of the Fair. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12:00 p.m.
6. No entries will be released prior to the printed release date and time. Entries may be removed on the Monday following the Fair from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Judging:

1. Uniformity of size, shape, and color.
2. Freedom from defects due to insects, disease, and mechanical injury.
3. Trueness to type for the variety.
4. Proper stage of maturity for table use.

Number in parenthesis is the exact number of items recommended for entry.
