All vegetables and fruits must be grown by the exhibitor.

No person may enter more than one entry under the same Class number.

Class	Description
01	Entomology display, insects properly mounted, labeled with order and local name and in a display case - Minimum of 10 insects in display
02	Agricultural display, collection of insects harmful to agricultural crops in Tennessee.
03	Agricultural display, damage done by insects.
04	Wildlife plant display, must contain at least 10 different kinds of recommended plants for wildlife plot bundled together.
