## Open Hereford Show

### Division 504

#### RULES

1. Exhibitors in Hereford classes are subject to the Association's special rule on class qualification, any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible for show. All Hereford animals must be officially recorded at show time to be eligible to show. Entries with registrations "Pending" or "Applied for" will be ineligible to show.
2. All Polled Hereford/Hereford entries must be registered in the American Hereford Assoc. All entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the Board of Directors of the American Hereford Association, and are subject to supervision of the show-Sale Committee representing the AHA.
3. Cattle *MUST* be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show's entry deadline date. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual class.
4. Common ownership of all four animals in the Get-of-Sire Classes is not required, but entry must be entered/exhibited in the name of only one herd, unless all four animals have the same joint ownership. A common or same ownership of all animals in the Best Six head entry is required.

Class Description  
 01 \*Cow/Calf (Any female older than the above ages with calf at side).  
 Calf older than 270 days of age on the show date is not eligible to show in cow/calf class. In the cow/calf class, if the cow is horned and the calf polled then the pair will show in the horned cow/calf Class and if the cow is polled and the calf is horned then the pair will show in the polled cow/calf class. Calf is eligible for individual Classes but must be entered in the appropriate class.

\*Cow/Calf does not compete for overall champion female.

- 03 Junior Heifer Calves, calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, this year.

- 06 Winter Heifer Calves, calved Nov. 1 through Dec. 31, last year.
- 07 Senior Heifer Calves, calved Aug. 1 through Oct. 31, last year.
- 08 Fall Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 6 & 7.
- 09 Reserve Fall Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 6 & 7.
- 10 Late Summer Yearling Heifers calved June 16 through July 31, last year.

- 11 Early Summer Yearling Heifers calved May 1 through June 15, last year.
- 12 Intermediate Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 10 & 11.
- 13 Reserve Intermediate Heifer Champion chosen from 1st and 2nd place winners in Cls 10 & 11.
- 14 Spring Yearling Heifer, calved March 1 through Apr. 30, last year.
- 15 Spring Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 1st place winner in Cls 14.
- 16 Reserve Spring Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 2nd place winner in Cls 14.
- 17 Junior Yearling Heifer, calved Jan. 1 through Feb. 29, last year.
- 18 Junior Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in Cls 17.
- 19 Reserve Junior Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in Cls 17.
- 20 Senior Yearling Heifer, calved Aug. 1 through Dec. 31, year before last.
- 21 Senior Champion Heifer, chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in Cls 20.
- 22 Reserve Senior Champion Heifer, chosen from 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in Cls 20.
- 23 Grand Champion Heifer chosen from the Jr. Heifer Calf, Fall, Heifer Calf, Intermediate, Spring Yearling, Jr. Yearling and Senior Champion Females.
- 24 Reserve Grand Champion Heifer chosen from the Jr. Heifer Calf, Fall Heifer Calf, Intermediate, Spring Yearling, Jr. Yearling and Senior Champion Females plus the female that stood 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Grand Champion Female.
- 25 Spring Bull Calves, calved after March 1, this year.
- 26 Junior Bull Calves, calved between January 1 and February 29, this year.
- 27 Junior Bull Calf Champion chosen from first place winners in Cls 25 & 26.
- 28 Reserve. Jr. Bull Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 25 & 26.
- 29 Winter Bull Calves, calved between Nov. 1 and Dec. 31, last year.
- 30 Senior Bull Calves, calved between Aug. 1 and Oct. 31, last year.
- 31 Fall Bull Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 29 & 30.
- 32 Reserve Fall Bull Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 29 & 30.
- 33 Late Summer Yearling Bulls, calves between June 16 and July 31, last year.
- 34 Early Summer Yearling Bulls, calved between May 1 and June 15, last year.
- 35 Intermediate Bull Champion chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 33 & 34
- 36 Reserve Intermediate Bull Champion chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in Cls 33 & 34.
- 37 Spring Yearling Bulls, calved between March 1 and April 30, last year.
- 38 Junior Yearling Bulls, calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, last year.
- 39 Yearling Bull Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 37 & 38.
- 40 Res. Yearling Bull Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 37 & 38.
- 41 Senior Yearling Bulls, calved Aug. 1 through Dec. 31, year before last.
- 42 Two-year old Bulls, calved Jan. 1 through July 31, year before last.
- 43 Senior Bull Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 41 & 42.
- 44 Reserve Sr. Bull Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 41 & 42.
- 45 Grand Champ Bull chosen from the Jr. Bull Calf, Fall Bull Calf, Inter. Bull, Yrly. Bull, and Sr. Bull.
- 46 Reserve Grand Champion Bull chosen from the Jr. Bull calf, Fall Bull calf, Inter. Bull, Yrly. Bull, and Sr. Bull plus the bull that stood 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Grand Champion Bull.
- 47 Get-of-Sire - four animals shown in above single entry classes with both sexes represented and all progeny of one sire. It is permissible to use either the cow or calf from a cow/calf pair for the Get of Sire. Get of Sire may be comprised of animals from one or more owners.
- 48 Best Six Head-All animals must have been shown in their respective single entry classes and they must be owned by the exhibitor or by a member of his/her immediate family. A cow/calf will be considered as two head in the Best Six Head. Best Six Head may be comprised of both horned and polled animals.
- 49 Premier Exhibitor \*Banner\*
- 50 Premier Breeder \*Banner\*

\*Awarded with the following point system: 1st place = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, and 5th = 1 point. No points will be given for champions. Points will be awarded for the Best Six Head for Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder. The same scoring system as above will be used for awarding points for the group classes.

# Junior Open Hereford Show

## Division 505

### Junior Show Rules: (Also read General Rules)

1. The Junior Open Beef Show(s) will run simultaneously with the Open Breed Show(s).
2. The animal entered in the Junior Show must also be entered in the Open Show.
3. Only a 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member may exhibit animals in this show. The junior exhibitor must show their own animal(s). If a junior exhibitor has more than one animal in any one class, the exhibitor can have another junior exhibitor show that second animal.
4. This junior show will be governed by the National Breed and Junior Associations Rules and Regulations.
5. All animals/embryos exhibited must have been recorded, registered or transferred in the exhibitor's name on or before August 10th of the current year.
6. Cow/Calf Classes will not compete for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female of the junior show.
7. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
8. Ribbons will be awarded for the first five placing's. Rosette's will be awarded for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
9. All decisions by the beef department head regarding eligibility in the Junior Show(s) are final.

### Class Description

- 05 Reserve Jr. Heifer Calf Champion. chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 1 & 2 .
- 06 Winter Heifer Calves, calved Nov. 1 through Dec. 31, last year.
- 07 Senior Heifer Calves, calved Aug. 1 through Oct. 31, last year.
- 08 Fall Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 5 & 6.
- 09 Reserve Fall Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 5 & 6.
- 10 Late Summer Yearling Heifers calved June 16 through July 31, last year.
- 11 Early Summer Yearling Heifers calved May 1 through June 15, last year.
- 12 Intermediate Heifer Calf Champion chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 9 & 10.
- 13 Reserve Intermediate Heifer Champion chosen from 1st and 2nd place winners in Cls 9 & 10.
- 14 Spring Yearling Heifer, calved March 1 through Apr. 30, last year.
- 15 Spring Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 1st place winner in Cls 13.
- 16 Reserve Spring Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 2nd place winner in Cls 13.
- 17 Jr. Yearling Heifer, calved Jan. 1 through Feb. 29, last year.
- 18 Jr. Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in Cls 16
- 19 Res. Jr. Yearling Heifer Champion chosen from 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in Cls 16
- 20 Senior Yearling Heifer, calved Aug. 1 through Dec. 31, year before last.
- 21 Senior Champion Heifer, chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in Cls 17.
- 22 Reserve Senior Champion Heifer, chosen from 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in Cls 17.
- 23 Grand Champion Heifer chosen from the Jr. Heifer Calf, Fall, Heifer Calf, Intermediate, Spring Yearling, Jr. Yearling and Senior Champion Females.
- 24 Reserve Grand Champion Heifer chosen from the Jr. Heifer Calf, Fall Heifer Calf, Intermediate, Spring Yearling, Jr. Yearling and Senior Champion Females plus the female that stood 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Grand Champion Female.
