## Open Shorthorn Show Division 500

### Rules:

1. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
2. **All cattle must be purebred and have an original American Shorthorn Association registration paper (no copies accepted or faxes accepted)** to be eligible to show. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the ASA by the time of the fair or show.
3. Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes **for single** animals. Multiple owned animals must be exhibited in the name of all owners. Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors in Junior Divisions and subsequently entered in Open Divisions may be treated as family entries in group Divisions.
4. All Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the ASA.
5. All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the ASA and the **DECISION OF THE EXAMINING VETERINARIAN IS FINAL.**
6. Use of artificial fins in show animals is not permitted.

- 04 Early Spring Heifer Calves - calved in March, this year.
- 05 Early Spring Heifer Calves - calved in April, this year.
- 06 Early Spring Heifer Calf Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 04 & 05.
- 07 Early Spring Heifer Calf Reserve Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 04 & 05
- 08 Jr. Heifer Calves - calved in January, this year.
09. Jr. Heifer Calves - calved in February, this year.
10. Jr. Heifer Calf Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 08 & 09.

- 20 Early Spring Yearling Females-calved between Mar 1 and Apr 30, last year.
- 21 Jr Champion Female-chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls 20.
- 22 Reserve Junior Champion Female – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls 20.
- 23 Junior Yearling Females - calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, last year.
- 24 Senior Yearling Females - calved between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, year before last.
- 25 Sr. Champion Female - chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 23-24.
- 26 Res Sr. Champ Female- chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in Cls 23-24.
- 27 Two-Year Old Cow/Claf Class – cows born between Jan. 1 – Aug. 31, 201.
- 28 Three-Four Year Old Cow/Calf Class – cows born between Jan. 1, 2013 – Dec. 31, 2014.  
**Both Cow and calf must be Purebred Shorthorn – Calf age may not exceed 280 days of age on show day.**
- 29 Champion Cow/Calf pair – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Cls. 27-28.
- 30 Reserve Champion Cow/Calf Pair – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners from Cls. 27-28.
- 31 Grand Champion Female - chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior, Senior and Cow/Calf Pair Champion females.
- 32 Reserve Grand Champion Female - chosen from Late Spring Calf, Early Spring Calf, Jr. Calf, Sr. Calf, Intermediate, Junior, Senior and Cow/Calf Pair Champion and Reserve Champion females.
- 33 Group of Two Females bred and owned or co-owned by breeder (exhibitor).

Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all Open shows: If a Purebred Female has a ShorthornPlus calf at side, it is not eligible for the Purebred Shorthorn Show, however it is eligible for the ShorthornPlus show. All females 20 months old at the time of the show need to be a 60-day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show and are subject to blood test to prove pregnancy. Exhibitors may be asked to present said verification upon the request of the Show officials or ASA representatives. If verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site, and verify a 60-day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that animal for that specific show.

- 37 Early Spring Bull Calves - calved between March 1 and April 30, this year.
- 38 Early Spring Bull Calf Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls. 37.
- 39 Early Spring Bull Calf Reserve Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls. 37.
- 40 Junior Bull Calves - calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 29, this year.
- 41 Jr Bull Calf Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in Cls. 40.
- 42 Jr. Bull Calf Res Champion – chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Cls. 40.
- 43 Winter Bull Calves - calved between Nov. 1 and Dec. 31, last year.
- 44 Senior Bull Calves - calved between Sept. 1 and Oct. 31, last year.
- 45 Senior Bull Calf Champion - chosen from 1st place winners in Cls 43-44.
- 46 Sr. Bull Calf Reserve Champion - chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in Cls 43-44.
- 47 Summer Yearling Bulls - calved between July 1 and August 31, last year.
- 48 Late Spring Yearling Bulls - calved between May 1 and June 30, last year.

 61 Group of Two Bulls - Bred and owned or co-owned by the breeder (exhibitor).  
 62 Super Cow Division - Class should consist of two (2) offspring of either or same sex of show age classification. Offspring do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one pair from each cow can win a prize in the class.  
 63 Get-of-Sire Division - Class should consist of three offspring, of either or same sex of any age from the same sire. Offspring do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one group from each sire can win a prize in the class..  
 64 Breeders Herd- Owned or co-owned by the exhibitor or working family (ie Father, Mother, Brothers, Sisters, Aunts & Uncles).

## Junior Open Shorthorn Show

### Division 501

#### Junior Show Rules: (Also read General Rules)

1. The Junior Open Beef Show(s) will run simultaneously with the Open Breed Show(s).
2. The animal entered in the Junior Show must also be entered in the Open Show.
3. Only a 4-H, FFA or Junior Breed Association member may exhibit animals in this show. The junior exhibitor must show their own animal(s). If a junior exhibitor has more than one animal in any one class, the exhibitor can have another junior exhibitor show that second animal.
4. This junior show will be governed by the National Breed and Junior Associations Rules and Regulations.
5. All animals/embryos exhibited must have been recorded, registered or transferred in the exhibitor's name on or before August 10th of the current year.
6. Cow/Calf Classes will not compete for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female of the junior show.
7. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
8. Ribbons will be awarded for the first five placing's. Rosette's will be awarded for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
9. All decisions by the beef department head regarding eligibility in the Junior Show(s) are final.
