#### Rules:

1. Entries must be produced by exhibitor.
2. All entries must be in farmer's name or farm name.
3. One (1) entry per farm per class will be entered.
4. Entries must be composed of forage which has been cut, cured, baled with standard hay baling equipment, and stored in a barn. Entry to consist of 9" - 12" block of hay from a small square bale. Entries must be tied with two (2) strings which run parallel in the same direction. Or, entries form a round bale should consist of a standard 13 gallon trash bag filled with hay from one round bale.
5. Questionable entries or those which do not conform to contest rules will be disqualified.
6. Entries will be received from 9:00 am. to 12:00 p.m. at the Agricultural Building on Thursday prior to opening day of the Fair. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12:00 NOON.** The management will receive entries brought in by the exhibitor/agent or sent prepaid by mail or express, marked attention "Tennessee State Fair Forage Show" 625 Smith Ave Suite 200, Nashville, TN 37203, and see that such entries are properly displayed. **DO NOT send entry forms in boxes with forage entries. Entries should be mailed in separately by the deadline. The Tennessee State Fair will take all reasonable care with your forage entries, but it is NOT responsible for any damage or loss.** Each forage entry must be properly tagged, stating exhibitor name, Department, Division, and Class entered. Exhibitor is entitled to reclaim any or all of his forage entries by the scheduled release time, but the management will not be responsible for returning or forwarding entries by mail or express. Any other arrangement for the disposing of the forage entries, other than those outlined, will be the direct responsibility of the exhibitor.
7. Exhibits will be removed on Monday following the Fair from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m..
