

752 Ready-To-Spin

Sheep Wool

01. Wool, Ready-to-Spin – At least 8 oz. of fiber from exhibitor's sheep, processed as exhibitor desires. Include a card describing the fiber and process methods.
02. 75% Wool Blend Ready-to-Spin – Same as Wool, Ready-to-Spin but up to 25% other fiber included.
03. 50% Wool Blend Ready-to-Spin – Same as Wool, Ready-to-Spin but up to 50% other fiber included.

Alpaca

04. Alpaca, Ready-to-Spin – At least 8 oz. of fiber from exhibitor's alpacas, processed as exhibitor desires. Include a card describing fiber and processing method.
05. Alpaca Blend, Ready-to-Spin – Same as Alpaca, Ready-to-Spin but up to 25% other fiber included.
06. Hand Spun Alpaca Skein – At least 1 oz. of fiber from exhibitor's alpacas. Include a card describing fiber, technique used, and yardage. List spinner's name on a separate card, to be displayed after judging.
07. Mill Spun Alpaca Skein – At least 1 oz. of fiber from exhibitor's alpacas. Include a card describing fiber, technique used, and yardage. List mill name on a separate card, to be displayed after judging.

1. Contestants will be furnished two ounces of wool roving.
2. Entries can now be made using the on-line system, which is strongly encourage.
3. Entries are accepted the day of the contest without a late fee.
4. Each competition lasts (8) eight minutes.
5. Novice classes are open to anyone who has been spinning less than one year.
6. Open classes are open to all spinners.
7. Fleece Show Judge or Department Head will select winner of Judge's Award at the end of the spinning contest.
8. Each contestant is automatically entered in a drawing for 4 ounces of ready to spin fiber, to be awarded at the end of the spinning contest. Limit one entry per contestant.
